Here's where you can eat pasta

to help earthquake victims

Sharing a meal has long been a means of providing comfort to those in crisis, and a group of Italian restaurants across Australia are hoping to do just that for those in the earthquake-devastated town of Amatrice. The small Italian village, which was almost completely lost in the 6.2 magnitude quake, has a proud tradition of food and their namesake dish, amatriciana pasta, is enjoyed the world over.



Many and widespread are the spontaneous manifestations of solidarity by communities and associations of Italians residing abroad in support of the populations recently struck by the earthquake in Central Italy. In order to effectively funnel these expressions of sympathy and of the will to make a tangible contribution, the Foreign Ministry has widely publicized information on the different collection channels and on the Authorities responsible for receiving the voluntary contributions through the Italian media abroad, the Comites and other Italian associations.

Moreover, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation has launched an information campaign through all its social channels and overseas networks in order to enable the Regions struck by the earthquake and the Authorities responsible for managing the emergency to receive the numerous offers of contributions and donations from abroad.
